ACCEPTED AT NO CHARGE:

- Aerosol Cans:** Hazardous Waste
- Batteries:** Household & Automobile
- Electronics:** Computer, Printer, and Accessories
- Fluorescent Light Bulbs**
- Paint Cans:** Not to Exceed 5 Gallons
- Pesticide, Insecticide, and Fertilizer**
- Propane Tanks:** Up to 20 lbs.
- Sharps:** In Closed Container
- Used Motor Oil:** Filters & Antifreeze
- White Goods/Large Appliances:** Stove, Refrigerator, Washer, Dryer, Dishwasher, Etc.
